



COMBAT SUICIDES & MASS SHOOTINGS (UMC Summary)

July 09, 2024

In the North Central Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church, a pioneering <u>Faith-Based</u> approach to tackle the escalating crisis of mass shootings and suicides has been established. This initiative has taken shape through the launch of a website, <u>www.ReThinkHopeUMC.org</u>, referred to as <u>ReTH</u>. The Objective: <u>Reach troubled persons before</u> they get to crisis mode and decide to commit such destructive acts.

UMCs that decide to get involved in the campaign to help persons struggling with thoughts of committing suicide, may use **ReTH** in part or as fully outlined. They will have the full support from the **ReTH Development Team** whose members are from different **UMCs** and other Christian Denominations.

The **website** is a growing informational hub of statistical data and various crisis management resources. **ReTH** is not the only way to carry this fight. **ReTH** is an approach of '**What to Do** <u>Now</u>'...**Prayer with Action**!

ReTH's <u>Affirmation of Faith</u>, expressed in the **Nicene Creed**, is poised to make a significant reduction in suicides. A few noteworthy features of this initiative:

- **Dedicated Prayer Phone Line and Prayer Wall** aim to provide support to those facing circumstances that may be pushing them toward thoughts of suicide or contemplating mass shootings.
- Messages of Hope, with <u>Reality Checks</u>, targeting persons on the edge of destruction. These messages posted on the ReTH website will also appear on Billboards at selected locations, as well as on Flyers, Posters, and other items used to promote this ministry (i.e. T-shirts, cups, pens, etc.).

The UMCs Becomes a 'First-Line of Contact', an Oasis, for persons on the edge of self-destruction. Volunteers are needed for every segment of this ministry:

- **ReTH Advocate Teams** will offer support to *troubled persons*, coordinating activities including training and getting support from local agencies.
- **ReTH Group Encounter Meetings UMCs** can offer forums (public and private) for troubled persons to air their pain.
- **ReTH Victims Assistance ReTH Advocates** will stand 'shoulder to shoulder' with bereaved family members, traumatized by suicide.





Additionally, the **ReTH** website will serve as a platform to connect individuals with professional help through the promotion of the **988 Suicide Crisis Hotline**. <u>ReTH Ministry endeavors to bridge the gap between faith-based support and professional intervention</u>.

50,000+ suicides recorded in 2023. 1453 school shootings since 2022. The data dictates action is needed '*NOW*' to combat this crisis! Are you ready to help?

What's needed today is for <u>UMCs</u> to say, 'Yes' to the <u>ReThink Hope Ministry with</u> <u>volunteers</u> to support it by doing the following:

- Establish ReTH Advocate Team (3-5): Schedule a <u>Town Hall Kick-off Meeting</u> announcing ReTH to the surrounding community where attendees would hear how this ministry plans to combat this crisis.
- Establishing contact with local agencies that are in this *battle*.
- Look for platforms that will allow the **ReTH Message** to be broadcast.
- Allow the **ReTH** link to be accessible from **UMC's** main web page.
- Give **ReTH** a presence at local street venues and fund raisers.
- Financially Supporting ReTH \$10 a month from each UMC member would help cover website expenses, printing posters, renting billboards, conducting Suicide Prevention Training Classes, and the Prayer Request Phone System.
